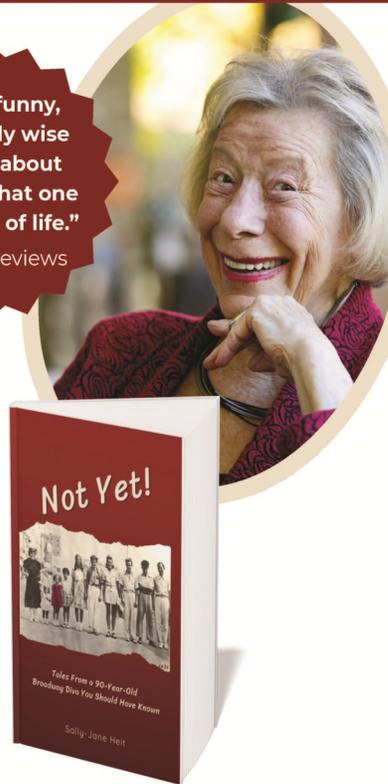
Writer and performer Sally-Jane Heit defied the odds and, at the spry age of 91, wrote and published her memoir, *Not Yet!*.

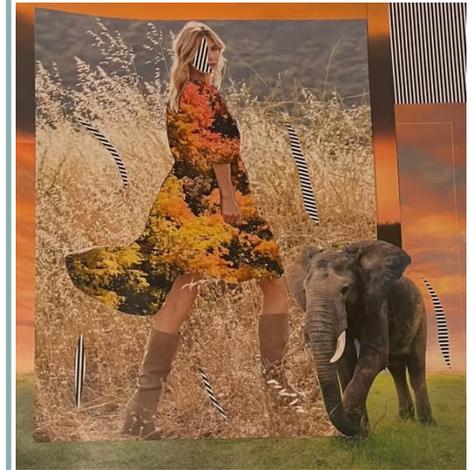

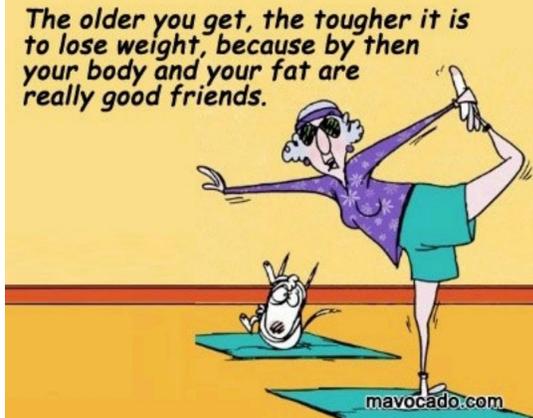

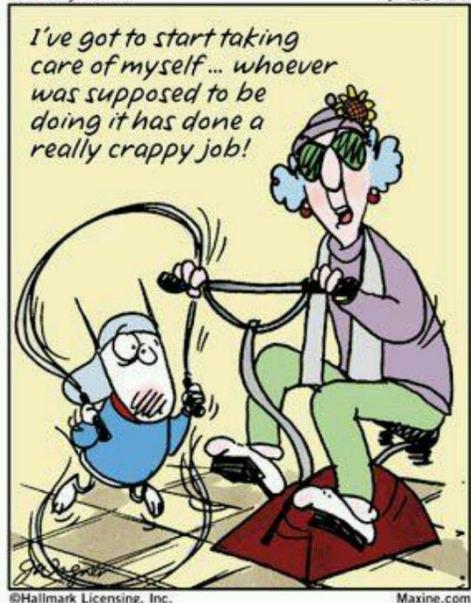
- **SHINE COUNSELOR**

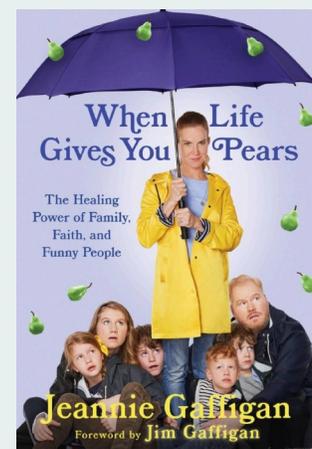

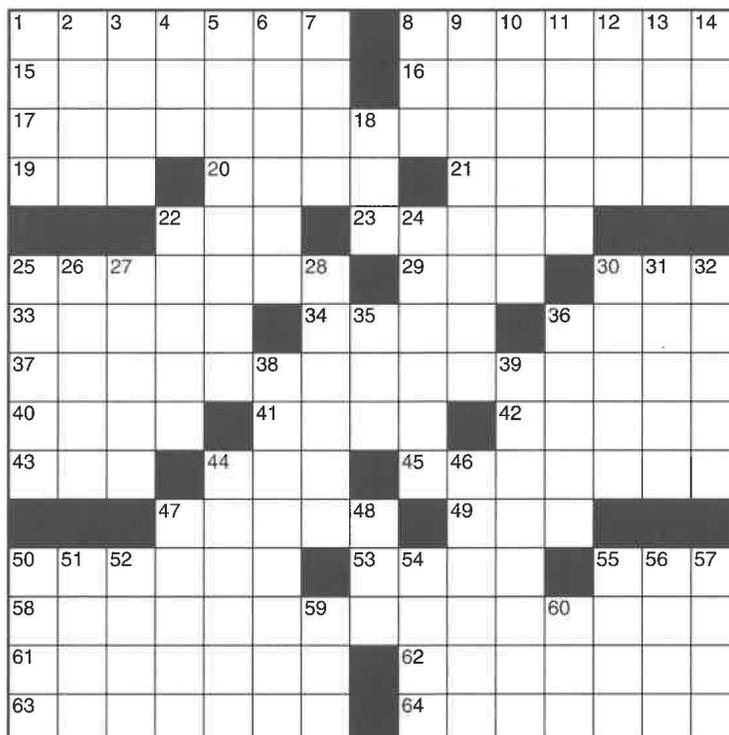
