803	Gasoline/Fuel station only = 1 unit

901	10 or less employees = 1 unit	340, 341, 342

Assessor Codes

Note: Equivalent Dwelling Units with 3 plus baths = 1.5 units
Commercial Units may be charged 1.5 units, 2.5 units, etc.
Commercial Units less than 500 square feet = One half (1/2) unit

Facility Connection Charges -1/1/2019 (based on Massachusetts General Law 15.203: *System Sewage Flow Design Criteria*)

New construction: \$15.00/gallon

Residential/Commercial: Existing buildings \$7.50/gallon

Note: Any sewer connection will be billed regardless of water usage unless sewer line is capped off outside of building.

2000 **Rebate Policy:** Any code listing not in use for 1 year before rebate available.
The Board of Sewer Commissioners is the only authority that may issue rebates.

Note: 2% included in each bill for billing costs
8% included for future expenditures
