MEETING FOCUS: Review of draft presentation in preparation for the second community forum.

- The forum is planned to proceed along these talking points:
 - Review community input from last meeting
 - Discuss options for lake Mansfield Road-
 - Discuss parking options for beach and boat launch
 - Receive community input of presented options
 - Establish goals for next meeting
- While reviewing current road conditions and possible options it was suggested that a specific meeting with the homeowner and representatives of the Pool Club be set up to get their feedback and input.
- Christine Ward commented that the community needs to be made aware the depth of work and associated costs involved with fixing the road. Any of the suggested options would involve rebuilding the road.
- As the presentation progresses, and looks at specific combination of options, there are general indications of the costs represented by one to four \$ symbols, as well as bullet point pros and cons.
- Klye explained that leaving the road as it but making parking improvements for Lake Mansfield Road could be a start to later improvements done in phases. With other options being phased it at different times.
- KZLA will prepare another online survey focused on the options presented for the beach area, road and boat launch.
