I. Lisa Bozzuto called the meeting to order at 5:31 PM. Present were members Michael Wise and tree warden Michael Piretti. Absent: Beth Moser, Hilda Banks Shapiro.

II. Minutes of the meeting of October 5, 2016 were approved, without objection.

III. Old business

A. Senior housing planting possibility

Bozzuto has talked with DPW about what can be done here; apparently, some money could probably be found for a couple of trees. Nan Wile presented schematics about where they would go. Wile said it is clear where some trees have been removed close to the line. The area at issue is below a berm. Piretti said that precise location of the town right-of-way line is probably not critical. Piretti said he could proceed to plant as soon as the trees are available, and it would be best to proceed soon, before a hard freeze. Bozzuto will follow up with a letter to Joe Sokul, to try to get some action while Joe is still here. Tom Whelan will also be approached to see whether he has some to spare.

The application's information about requests for removal will show none were rejected.


V. Citizen speak time
