PUBLIC MEETINGS SCHEDULED ON PROPOSED BRTA ROUTE CHANGES

The Berkshire Regional Transit Authority (BRTA) will host a series of virtual and in-person public meetings in February to gather public input on proposed changes to routes.

These meetings are intended to provide riders, residents, and stakeholders with an opportunity to learn about the proposed changes, ask questions, and share feedback.

Residents of Great Barrington are encouraged to participate in upcoming public meetings, as the proposed realignments may impact local routes, service coverage, and rider access in Great Barrington and surrounding areas.

BRTA is seeking public input to better understand community needs and ensure transit services continue to support residents, employees, seniors, students, and visitors.

Public comments received during these meetings will be compiled and presented to the BRTA Advisory Board at its March 4, 2026 meeting.
